Forms-I: Changes to NIH Application Forms for Due Dates on or after January 25, 2025

- NIH Common Form Implementation should not be confused with the Application Forms-I changes
- Changes with NIH Application Forms-I:
 - ✓ Updates to OMB Expiration Date on All Forms
 - ✓ Major Updates to PHS Fellowship Supplemental Form
 - ✓ Updates to PHS Assignment Request Form
 - ✓ Updates to Training Data Tables
 - ✓ Mentions the Adoption of NIH Common Forms for Biographical Sketch and Current and Pending (Other) Support due on May 25, 2025

NIH Adoption of Common Forms for Biographical Sketch and Current and Pending (Other) Support

- This NIH Guide Notice informs the extramural research community of NIH's adoption of Common Forms for Biographical Sketch and Current and Pending (Other) Support to be used with all applications, JITs, and RPPRs on or after May 25, 2025
- The Common Forms represent a collaborative effort between federal research agencies to ensure standard disclosure requirements
- Provides clarity regarding disclosure requirements (who discloses what, relevant limitations and exclusions), disclosure process (updates, corrections, certification, and provision of supporting documentation), and expected degree of crossagency uniformity

NIH Common Forms Implementation

- NIH currently plans to continue collecting three required agency specific data elements:
 - Personal Statement
 - Contributions to Science
 - Honors
- These data elements will be collected separately from the Common Forms on a new NIH Biographical Sketch Supplement



SciENcv

- <u>SciENcv</u> is a feature in MyNCBI that creates biosketches for NIH and NSF applications
- Education, employment, research activities, publications, honors, research grants, and other professional contributions can be included in profiles
- Add publications via My Bibliography (PubMed pubs) and ORCiD ID (for pubs not in PubMed)
- NIH will require the use of <u>SciENcv</u> to complete Common Forms (Biographical Sketch and Current and Pending (Other) Support) and the NIH Biographical Sketch Supplement to produce digitally certified PDF(s) for use in application submission as of May 25, 2025
- All Senior/Key Personnel will be required by NIH to link their ORCiD ID to their eRA Commons Personal Profile



Biographical Sketch Common Form

- NIH will require the use of the Common Form for Biographical Sketch effective May 25, 2025
- As of that date, NIH will no longer accept the current NIH Biographical Sketch format page
- Biographical Sketch Common Form provides instructions for submission by each individual identified as a senior/key person on a Federally funded research project
- Used to assess how well qualified the individual, team, or organization is to conduct the proposed activities
- Individuals are required to disclose contracts associated with participation in programs sponsored by foreign governments or entities, including foreign government-sponsored talent recruitment programs
- Individuals are prohibited from being a party in a malign foreign talent recruitment program
- NIH will require the use of a new NIH Biographical Sketch Supplement to collect:
 - Personal Statement
 - Contributions to Science
 - Honors



Biographical Sketch Common Form Format

- Identifying Information:
 - Name of Individual
 - Persistent Identifier (PID) of Senior/Key Person
 - Position Title
 - Organization Location
- Professional Preparation (degree and field of study)
- Appointments and Positions (academic, professional, and institutional)
- Products (Publications, Presentations, Websites, Technologies, Inventions, Patents, Licenses, Databases, Software, Models, Equipment, Interventions)
- Signed Certification (information is current, accurate, and complete) that shows individual is not a party in a malign foreign talent program
- Privacy Act and Burden Statement



Current and Pending (Other) Support Common Form

- NIH will require the use of the Common Form for Current and Pending (Other) Support as of May 25, 2025
- As of that date, NIH will no longer accept the current Other Support format page
- Assesses any conflicts of commitment that may impact the ability of the individual to carry out the research effort as proposed
- Assesses any potential scientific and budgetary overlap or duplication with the project being proposed
- A separate submission must be provided for each proposal and active project, as well as inkind contributions
- No page limitation
- Consulting activities must be disclosed under the active projects section of the form
- Required to disclose contracts associated with participation in programs sponsored by foreign governments, instrumentalities, or entities, including foreign government-sponsored talent recruitment programs
- Individuals are prohibited from being a party in a malign foreign talent recruitment program



Current and Pending (Other) Support Common Form Format

- Identifying Information
 - Name of Individual

 - Position Title
 - Organization and Location
- Proposals and Active Projects
 - Title
 - Status of Support
 - Award Number
 - Source of Support
 - Primary Place of Performance
 - Project Start and End Dates
 - Total Anticipated Project Award Amount
 - Person-Months Devoted to Project Per Year
 - Overall Objectives
 - Statement of Potential Overlap
- In-Kind Contributions
- Signed Certification (current, accurate, and complete) shows not a party in a malign foreign talent program
- Privacy Act Burden Statement

Applications and RPPRs due before May 25, 2025

• Continue using the current <u>NIH Biosketch</u> and <u>Other Support</u> format pages for applications, Just-in-Time and RPPRs.



Applications and RPPRs due <u>on or after</u> May 25, 2025

 Use the Common Forms – Biographical Sketch, Current and Pending (Other) Support, and NIH Biographical Sketch Supplement – along with the updated instructions for applications, JITs and RPPRs

 Failure to use the required format pages may cause NIH to withdraw your application from consideration of funding



Availability of NIH Common Forms

- NIH is in the process of aligning specific fields and instructions to the Common Forms and will post the NIH instructions of the Common Forms and NIH Biographical Sketch Supplement once approved
- NIH will update application forms, instructions, and resources to support the need for applicants to provide full transparency and disclosure of all research activities (foreign and domestic)
- NIH is coordinating with SciENcv on the development of the Common Forms for use by NIH applicants



What Can You Do Now to Prepare

- 1. Familiarize yourself with **SciENcv**
 - You will be required to use SciENcv to complete NIH Common Forms which will produce digitally certified PDF(s) for use in application submission
 - PI signatures in SciENcv cannot be delegated
- 2. Get an ORCID ID
 - ORCiD ID is a free, unique, persistent identifier for individuals to use as they engage in research
 - All senior/key personnel listed on an application due on or after May 25, 2025, <u>must</u> have an ORCiD ID and it must be linked to eRA Commons Personal Profile
 - You will be required to enter your ORCiD ID in the PI section of the Common Form Biosketch



Importance of NIH Common Forms

- We can have robust research collaborations, enhanced integrity, and security of NIH funded research at the same time
- For this to happen, full transparency and disclosure of all foreign and domestic research activities is needed




Creating a new NIH biosketch in SciENcv


